1. Prove that for every bounded sequence $x_n \in \mathbb{R}$

Let
$$\lim_{n\to\infty} \inf x_n \leq \limsup_{n\to\infty} x_n.$$

$$\chi_n = \inf \left\{ \chi_k : k \geq n \right\},$$

$$\chi_n = \sup \left\{ \chi_k : k \geq n \right\}$$
Therefore,
$$\chi_n \leq \chi_n \leq \lim_{n\to\infty} \chi_n \leq \lim_{n\to\infty} \chi_n = \lim_{n\to\infty} \chi_n.$$
